



Highcliff Elementary School Supply Lists 2019-20

The following supplies are provided by North Hills School District throughout the school year: *crayons, pencils, paper, glue sticks, scissors, file folders, binders and/or other items needed by the curriculum.* The items listed below are what teachers have typically used/requested for their classrooms. If your family is going to be purchasing school supplies this summer, suggestions are listed below by grade level.

All students will need to have a regular size backpack. Please do not send trapper keepers or art kits. Various agencies and individuals have donated backpacks to Highcliff Elementary School for families experiencing hardship. The backpacks are available in August by contacting the school office at 412-318-1582

Kindergarten

Please label everything! If possible, bring your child's supplies to kindergarten orientation on August 16.

- Scissors ("*Fiskars*" scissors with a blunt tip are the best when learning how to cut)
- Two fat glue sticks
- Large, old shirt (*for art projects*)
- Change of clothes (including underwear) for locker, labeled and placed in a labeled bag
- Disinfecting wipes
- Box of Kleenex
- One pair of headphones (no ear buds) in a Ziploc bag with name marked
- Yoga mat (Please stick to the thin mats that can be rolled. Five Below has the perfect mats for \$5)
- A 24 Box of crayons (*Crayola, if possible*)
- One large pink eraser
- Girls - box of large (gallon) zipper baggies
- Boys - box of sandwich zipper baggies

**Please do not send in supplies that are not on the list such as markers, sharpeners, pens, notebooks, binders, etc. In addition, do not purchase a pencil case until your child's teacher shares what she prefers at Kindergarten Orientation.*



Grade 1

- Pencil box
- 12 sharpened pencils
- Scissors
- 5 glue sticks
- A box of crayons (*no larger than 24 crayons per box*)
- A box of tissues to share with the class
- A container of Clorox Wipes
- One pair of headphones in a Ziploc bag with name marked
- 2 dry erase markers
- Class sized snack (*goldfish, pretzels, etc.*)
- Old shirt to wear during art projects
- A 4-pack of playdough

Grade 2

- 1 pair student scissors
- 12 sharpened pencils (*minimum*)
- 1 package colored pencils
- 2 different colored highlighters
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 box of crayons (*24 pack*)
- 2 dry erase markers
- 1 pair of old socks to clean dry erase boards
- Hand held sharpener with lid (*optional*)
- Pencil box/pouch (*to hold above items*)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 pair of personal earbuds in a Ziploc bag with name- compatible with iPad
- 1 container of Clorox Wipes – Citrus/Lemon scent OR 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 smock or an oversized t-shirt for art
- Full change of clothes in a gallon Ziploc bag with name for falls or spills

Please initial as many of the items as possible.



Grade 3

- 2 highlighters any color (*unscented*)
- 10 pencils (*Ticonderoga is the preferred brand*)
- 10 eraser tops for the top of the pencils
- 4 large (pink style) erasers.
- Scissors
- Colored pencils - a box of 12.
- 2 boxes of tissues for classroom supply
- Tool/pencil box - small size (8x5)
- Pencil sharpener that has a “catcher” on it
- 12 glue sticks to add to class supply.
- A box of 24 count Crayons; Crayola brand crayons last longer and work the best (*Boxes that hold more than 24 crayons are cumbersome*)
- Pens (1 red, 1 black, 1 blue)
- Some type of old shirt to use as an art shirt.
- Earbuds/headphones

Grade 4

- 1 to 2 inch three-ringed binder
- 3-ringed pencil pouch (carried inside binder)
- Box of markers
- Box of wooden pencils (no mechanical)
- Box of colored pencils
- 2 highlighters
- 2 large erasers
- 2 glue sticks
- Scissors
- Tissue box for classroom
- Clorox wipes for classroom

Grade 5

- Highlighters (unscented)
- Colored pencils (markers optional in addition to crayons or colored pencils)
- Tissue box for classroom
- Baby wipes – not cleaning wipes so kids can use
- Pencil box - small size to fit inside desk
- Pencil sharpener that has a “catcher” on it
- Set of thin markers (optional)
- A book to read
- 2 red pens
- Headphones/earbuds to use with technology
- Clorox Wipes
- Box of pencils-wood or mechanical
- 1 pack of lined paper with 3 hole punch



Grade 6

- 4 highlighters (different colors)
- Colored pencils
- Scissors
- 2 tissue boxes for classroom
- Pencil pouch small size to fit inside desk
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue (put name on it)
- 3 black/white composition notebooks - lined, not graph paper(100 sheets/200 pages)
- Clorox wipes
- Headphones or earbuds for iPads
- 2 large pink erasers
- Pencils
- 2 binders (Math and ELA)
- 2 folders (Science and Social Studies)
