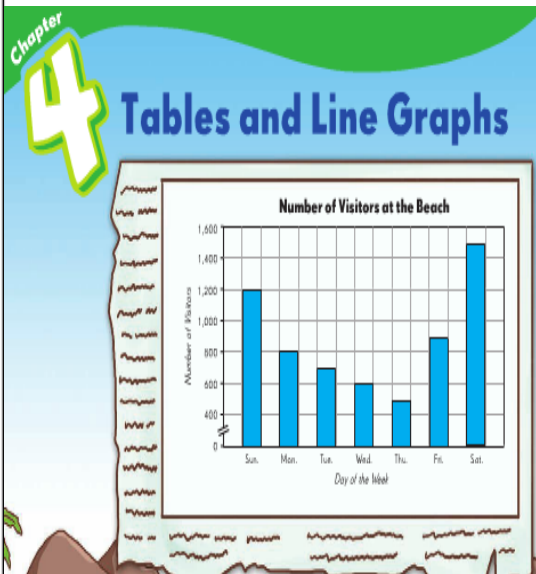

Chapter 4 Tables and Line Graphs

Dear Family,

In this chapter, your child will study tables and line graphs. Some of the skills your child will practice are:

- making and interpreting tables and line graphs
- choosing an appropriate graph to display a given data set



Vocabulary to Practice

A set of **data** is a set of information, usually numbers.

A **table** organizes and presents data in rows and columns.

Rows organize data in a table horizontally.

Columns organize data in a table vertically.

An **intersection** is the area of the table where a row and a column meet.

A **line graph** shows how data changes over time.

The **horizontal axis** on a graph is the line that runs straight across from left to right.

The **vertical axis** on a graph runs straight up and down.
