
There are 3 main verb tenses:


Past An action that already took place Usually, you add -ed to the end of the verb The est jumped onto the bod. But, some verbs are

Grammar: Action Verbs

- ☑ A verb tells that the subject does or is.

 Example: Heather <u>yawns</u>. She <u>is</u>

 sleepy.
 - ☑ A verb can include more than one word—a main verb and a helping verb.
 The main verb follows the helping verb.
 Example: Heather is yawning.
- ✓ Verbs can be present, past, or future tenses. Example: calls, called, will call
